

Minutes of a Special Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Rockland Community College held November 12, 1971 at 145 College Road, Suffern, New York.

PRESENT: Mr. Bratton, Mr. Brucker, Mr. Cobb, Dr. Fontaine, Mrs. Zeck, Dr. Eskow.

ABSENT: Dr. Ciancimino, Mr. Laskey, Dr. Rounds.

The meeting was called to order at 8:15 p.m. by Chairman Brucker who stated that, because Phase 2 of the President's Controls Program goes into effect November 15, 1971, the Administrative salaries for employees not included in the bargaining unit had to be fixed.

On motion made by Mr. Cobb, and seconded by Mrs. Zeck, it was


