

International Student Application Checklist

- ❑ **RCC application with fee:** Please be sure to indicate F-1 on the application. Please write your permanent home address in your home country on the application form, as this is needed for the SEVIS I-20. If you complete the online application, you can submit the \$30 application fee online. If you complete the paper application, the application fee of \$30 must be in the form of a U.S. bank check.
- ❑ **Official Transcripts:** You must show proof that you have equivalent to a U.S. high school diploma. This should include official secondary school transcripts (academic records) along with a completion certificate, and/or exam results (if applicable) in English or with English translation. For English translation, you can use any official service in your home country or local translation services in the U.S.
 - College or university transcripts from non-U.S. schools will need to be evaluated by a professional evaluation company to qualify for transfer credits. A course-by-course evaluation is needed.
- ❑ **Proof of English Proficiency:** Students from non-English speaking countries must submit acceptable English proficiency. Please see our English Proficiency Requirements page for details on what is required.
- ❑ **Bank Statement & Agreement of Financial Support:** You must show equivalent to \$22,500 U.S. in liquid funds. Please complete the Agreement of Financial Support & have it signed by your sponsor(s) whose name appears on the bank statement(s).
- ❑ **Passport:** A copy of the biographical page is required for the applicant and all dependents.
- ❑ **SEVIS I-20 and Mailing Information Form:** Please include information on any dependents and indicate how you would like to receive your documents.
- ❑ **Copies of current I-20/visa:** If you are currently in the U.S. and are transferring to RCC, we need a copy of your current I-20 and visa page
- ❑ **Immunization:** Proof of immunization against Measles, Mumps and Rubella. You must also submit the Meningitis Response Form. This is due prior to registering for classes at RCC.

Application Deadlines:
