

REVERSE TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
between
DOMINICAN COLLEGE
and
SUNY ROCKLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE

This agreement allows students who have transferred to Dominican College (DC) to complete an associate's degree back at SUNY Rockland Community College (RCC) while enrolled at DC. A student is eligible to apply for the reverse transfer agreement within three calendar years of the date on which he/she transferred to DC.

The student must sign a transcript release form in the Registrar's Office allowing DC to send his/her transcript to RCC for evaluation for an associate's degree. RCC decides how many credits the student must earn there in order to meet its residency requirement and be eligible for the degree. If RCC determines that the student has enough appropriate credits for an associate's degree, it will notify the student in writing.
