SUNY GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

Students must fulfill the Basic Communications and Mathematics requirement, as well as courses from 5 of the remaining areas.*

RCC students completing an **AA or an AS degree are encouraged to complete a minimum of 21** credits of general education (including Basic Communications and Math) **prior to transfer**. RCC students completing an **AAS degree are encouraged to complete a minimum of 15 credits** of general education prior to transfer (including Basic Communications and Math) **prior to transfer**
