The Early Admission Program affords high school students with an opportunity to be academically challenged by studying full-time on the campus of Rockland Community College during their senior year.

## **ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

Regardless of your SAT scores or AP grades, you must have a High School Average of 80/2.66, take the College ENGLISH and MATH PLACEMENT TESTS and place into ENGLISH 101 and MATH 101 or higher.

## **ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES**

- ▼ Complete the Rockland Community College Enrollment Application and attach a \$30 non-refundable application fee. A check or money order should be made out to Rockland Community College.
- ▼ Complete the Rockland Community College Early Admission Application.
- ▼ Return all applications to your high school guidance counselor.
- ▼ Your Guidance counselor will submit your applications together with an official high school transcript and immunizations records.
- ▼ You will be notified when to take the English and Math Placements if you meet the GPA requirements and you have submitted all the forms.
- ▼ Your placement results will be given to Admissions and you and your high school will be notified of your results.
- ▼ You must bring a list of courses required for your high school graduation to your meeting with an academic advisor prior to registration in any courses.
- ▼ If you are interested in EARLY ADMIT Honors, you must complete this process first.
