

# HOW TO Access your Program Evaluation & Transcript using WebAdvisor

Before meeting with your assigned Academic Advisor be sure to complete the steps below:

## To Review Your Program Evaluation

- LOG into *My RCC* and CLICK **WebAdvisor**
- CLICK on STUDENTS TAB
- SELECT **Program Evaluation** under the heading **Academic Profile**
- SELECT the degree you are following or SELECT a *What if...* and CLICK **SUBMIT**
- Review & PRINT to determine what courses are still required for graduation.
